

U3A E Newsletter March 2012



A request has been received as follows: I am a speech pathologist and PhD researcher at the University of Queensland and am carrying out a study looking at how recovery of language function occurs following a stroke. I am based at the University of Queensland Centre for Clinical Research which is on the Herston Campus at the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital, Brisbane and am studying stroke patients from the acute stroke unit at the hospital. The study has received full ethics approval from QH, UQ and the Royal Brisbane Hospital. As you may be aware, most people who have a stroke are over 65 years and as a result I am seeking to recruit healthy control subjects over 65 years so I can compare the findings with those from stroke patients.
