We have leased two large teaching spaces as well as a kitchen/ eating area and reception on Level1/344 Queen St just around the corner from our current Creek St rooms.. Surrounded by coffee shops, it has easy access and will be equipped with the most up-to-date equipment. New furnishings have been purchased and when we take over the lease on 16th December, we expect it to be an attractive, accessible space. When this article was written, 128 classes had been scheduled just in the Creek/Queen St rooms in Term 1. There are more than 20 new classes across a wide subject area so there should be something for everyone. The Management Committee has been working very hard over the last few months to ensure the financial viability of this expansion and to provide an attractive addition for our existing and ever-growing number of new

From Susan Baggio re new class - **Outdoor Sketching in Brisbane City**


